STATE EXPANDS ENTERPRISE ZONE TO CITY CENTER

Designation will stimulate development in region's oldest business district



The Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development has expanded the Enterprise Zones in Baltimore City to include an important section of Downtown.

Projects in a 45-acre section of City Center - bounded by Paca, President, Lombard, and Baltimore streets - are now eligible for tax incentives through this program that has successfully

stimulated development across the state.

Downtown Partnership strongly supports measures to help this older area of Downtown stay competitive. In particular, we have prioritized the redevelopment of First Mariner Arena and the former Mechanic Theatre.
